



Joint-Relationship with ORU

The Oral Roberts University School of LifeLong Learning coordinates with the ORU School of Theology and Missions to offer a unique Bible Institute program for those who are unable to attend a traditional Bible School. The Westmoreland School of Ministry, in joint-relationship with the ORU School of LifeLong Learning, offers a 19 credit Christian Workers Certificate, a 33 credit Advanced Certificate of Theology in Biblical Studies and a 66 credit Diploma of Theological Studies and Practical Ministry. Course offerings are developed by ORU and are taught by Master's Degreed faculty. Applications and transcripts are maintained by ORU.

Individuals who complete the Diploma of Theological Studies program may also establish advanced standing in ORU's undergraduate residential and distance education degree programs. Pending approval, various organizations or academic institutions, accept coursework toward pursuit of ministerial credentials or academic degree programs.



The non-credit audit option is available for those who desire bible school leadership and practical ministry training for the work of the church or personal ministry.

Diploma Theological Studies

The Diploma of Theological Studies is designed for Christians who desire intensive training in Biblical studies, theology, and practical ministries. This 66-credit hour approach to ministry training is especially attractive to pastors and laypersons in that the training is tailored to involve the laity in the ministries of the local church.

Advanced Certificate Theology

Students are awarded the Advanced Certificate of Theology upon completion of 33 hours of the diploma curriculum.

Theological Certificate in Biblical Studies

Short-term Certificates can be earned by individuals seeking training in Christian ministry in their local church. Certificates are earned upon completion of 19 credit hours in one of the following areas: Practical Ministry, Biblical Studies, or General Theological Studies



COURSE OFFERINGS FALL 2009

New Testament Survey

An introduction to the various books of the New Testament with an examination of in the historical, social, economic, and religious background.

Romans:Your Path to Victory

A basic study surveying the great truths found in Paul's letter to the Romans. Particular attention is given to the major doctrinal and exhortative sections of the book with an application to Christian life and practice.

Holy Spirit in the Now

Chancellor Roberts analyzes biblical concepts and principles that reveal the person and work of the Holy Spirit. Parallels of the dynamic ministry of the Spirit in today's world are clearly drawn.

Youth Ministry

Designed to educate and equip students to be youth ministers in the local church. Focus on understanding the foundations of ministry, roles and relationships of the youth minister, and administrative principles and strategies.

Bible Doctrines 1

Covers the idea of theology; the existence of God; Scripture as revelation; and the nature works and decrees of God. *D'THE 230 pre-requisite

Ministry Practicum

Provides students with practical experience in a broad range of roles performed in various areas of ministry. *12 credit prerequisite. Required for diploma program.

Application

Tuition, Books, Fees

Tuition for each course offering is \$210.00 payable before the add drop period. Courses may be audited for non credit at a lower tuition rate.
